# Greencroft's Spinach & Bacon Quiche

1- 9 inch refrigerated pie crust
1 1/2 cups shredded Swiss Cheese
1 lb. Bacon, cook and crumbled
2 cups chopped baby spinach
6 large eggs, beaten
1 1/2 cups heavy cream
Salt & pepper to taste

Preheat oven to 375 degrees. Combine the eggs, cream, salt and pepper in a food processor or blender. Layer the spinach, bacon and cheese in the bottom of pie crust, then pour the egg mixture on top. Bake 35-45 minutes until the egg mixture is set. Let cool for 30 minutes and then serve. Makes 8 servings.
