MANAGER'S REPORT

I hope that all of you have had a wonderful summer so far. Summer officially doesn't end until September 21st and we hope to extend that by keeping the pool open until the end of the month. Should the weather turn please check with us the last week of the month to make sure the pool is still open. We will send out a mass email letting you know if we close early. As you know, over the last several years we have closed the club on Tuesday evenings in January, February, July, and August. Over the last year during the other months, we are averaging only four to six diners on Tuesday evenings. As a result we are not planning to reopen for Tuesday evening dinner service unless someone wants a party of at least 16 people. We will remain open for lunch on Tuesdays as we have done all summer. In addition, we have considered adding another meal to the mix, a breakfast during the week, which would be a special buffet each week. Before starting that, we would like to hear from you.
