Linda Abbey- I paint to remember – how the light is at a certain time on a certain day, whether the shadows are hard on not, how soft the colors are. I like to paint watercolors with a big brush, using the accidents, transparency and freshness of the watercolor medium itself.

While teaching I completed an Associate Arts Degree in Art at PVCC. When I moved back to Syracuse in 1990, I began painting and exhibiting full time. I taught drawing and watercolor to elementary students in a city school and adult students privately in a nearby church or museum. In 2002 I was able to spend six months in Florence, Italy, studying Italian and oil painting with the Syracuse University Programs Abroad center. I spent two years again in Florence, 2008-2010, studying Italian and oil painting and teaching drawing and watercolor painting.
