Gallery at Greencroft

May will feature three new artists throughout our dining room galleries.

Jenny Abrams - "I have a life-long love of art painting, taking classes and doing projects as time allowed. When I met a group of central Virginia plein air painters through a friend at Beverly Street Studio School, I began spending increasing amounts of my free time working on paintings from life. Most of my work is done "alla prima" (in one sitting), usually on-site "en plein air" or with the subject in front of me. Virginia provides a never-ending source of beauty and the environment. In my painting, I attempt to capture it for others to see and experience."

Ron Martin - "Ron Martin has been a lifelong resident of Albemarle County, Virginia and it is the natural beauty and color of the County which inspires him to paint. Like many of his impressionist role models – Sisley, Pissaro and of course Monet, Ron prefers working "plein air". He feels the only true way to paint any object is to study the light as it reflects, warms, or shades the subject. He takes a great deal of pride in every stroke he places. "It's not about painting a pretty picture, but capturing that perfect color or stroke, however small," he says "that can make an entire afternoons painting worthwhile."

Susan B. Viemeister - "Working in my studio in Nelson County, Virginia and wandering in other areas throughout Central Virginia, I paint primarily in oils. I am a perceptual painter or a realist...take your pick. With a past life as a photographer I have always been conscious of light, composition and the intentional capture found in the edges of framing a view. But the charm of painting, unlike photography, leaves an evidence of being made by hand. Look at the surface of the paint on canvas, check out the precise or sloppy mark-making of a brush or pay close attention to the scrape of a palette knife by unsure fingers, all creating the patina of the hand made."

Larkin Mott, a Charlottesville native, is a daughter of original Members of Greencroft. She has extensive experience in the hospitality industry in the United States, Canada, and the Caribbean.
